

Monarch Virtual Simola Hillclimb

Assetto Corsa (PC)

Version: Season 2

Goals

To hold a PC-based sim racing series using Assetto Corsa over four rounds to find the top 10 finalists for both the classic Friday and King of the Hill classes.

The live top-10 final of the Classic Friday will be held on Friday 3rd September. The King of the Hill Grand final will take place over two days, Saturday 4th and Sunday 5th September.

Entry

Competitors must have Assetto Corsa (PC version only) and a valid steam account. In order to compete, the add-on Virtual Simola Hillclimb track must be downloaded and installed.

Entries in the Virtual Knysna Simola Hillclimb competition is free and no age restrictions are applicable. DLC content for Assetto Corsa might be required for some rounds.

Each competitor can enter **both** classes; Classic Friday and King of the Hill.

All nationals are allowed to enter the competition, but only South African residents can qualify for prizes. If the event is hosted on location in South Africa the minimum age is set at 18 years and competitors must be residing in South Africa.

A webcam or similar device with live streaming capabilities is compulsory when competing in the Finals.

Prizes

Prizes for the competition will be announced on Monday 23rd August.

Top 10 Finals

The top 10 point scoring competitors of each class will be invited to compete in the finals. If a competitor decides not to compete, we will select the first runner up in the championship standing until we have full field of 10 competitors.

The organization holds the rights to invite a wild card competitor for the finals.

Online Session Details

Three days before each round, the session details will be announced together with the cars that will be used for both classes. (Classic Friday and King of the Hill). One round will be a mystery car, which means that the car will only be announced at the start of the particular round.

Modification and weather settings are set by Monarch

Rounds

Each competitor has unlimited attempts to set an online time on the Monarch servers. A single fastest time set on the game server will be the SIM racers fastest time for that particular round and class.

Set Laps

1. Each online qualifying session has a duration of 60min after which it will restart.
2. Exit your pitbox and turn right towards the start line.
3. We expect each competitor to line up at the start line and proceed from a standing still position.
4. Finish your lap by crossing the Finish line at the top of the hill.
5. Stop your car and press Esc to return to the pits.
6. Repeat.

Replay save

Each competitor is obliged to save their fastest replay time set on the Monarch server. In case of a dispute, Monarch will require the replay in order to verify the set time. If a competitor fails to provide the replay or if an inconsistency is discovered, that time will be void.

Track updates

In order to compete in the online Virtual Knysna Simola Hillclimb the sim racer must have the latest version of the online track. Track updates may happen before the start of the next round. Track updates will be communicated on all communication platforms.

Car Livery

Competitors may be asked to install an additional free livery pack for the running round.

Points

P1 = 100 points

P2 = 95 points

P3 = 92 points

P4 -93 = 91 – 1 point

Public Behaviour

Public outbursts will be investigated as race incidents and penalties will be applied as such. This may include - but is not limited to - time penalties, qualifying bans or race/series bans.

Outbursts will include but not limited to the following:

- Finger-pointing aimed at race organisers and/or other drivers on public communication and social platforms
- Foul language in-game text
- Foul language in voice communication platforms
- Outbursts and beratement of organisers or drivers
- Live stream text chat behaviour may result in channel bans or race penalties for associated teammates
- Hacking and cheating may result in a lifetime ban from Virtual Knysna Simola Hillclimb events

Series Communication platforms

Each Series will have available to drivers multiple communication platforms for the purposes of providing Series-specific information as well as communication between drivers and race organisers. Certain communication platforms may be mandatory for drivers for improved incident and restart procedure communication.
